



RACE SIGNALS

The meaning of visual and sound signals are stated below. An arrow pointing up or down 1 + + means that a visual signal is displayed or removed. A dot (*) means a sound, five short dashes (----) mean repetitive sounds. A long dash (--) means a long sound. When a visual signal is displayed over a class flag, the signal only applies to that class


